#### **EXECUTIVE BOARD REPORT (5 MINUTES)**

#### President Report – Stacey Smith

- Expenses 2<sup>nd</sup> October Vote Passed, None for November

- Starting Balance \$27,344.21k
- Ending Balance \$43,031.98

  - Voted to Prepay \$400 for FundHub, save \$100 for next year
  - Harvest, total expenses came to \$1,346, received \$24 in donations
